On the weekend of May 11th & 12th (Mother's Day weekend) from 10 am to 5 pm, see the work of 19 artists at four locations. Meet professional artists at each stop who are ready to show you their work, share their techniques, and "talk art." Art in a variety of media will delight visitors.
